Dear Sirs,

With reference to your first entry report No. 10622 on the Hull of the s.s. "WAR VIGOUR" (now named "ANDALUSIER") I have to inform you that accounts have to-day been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping for the fees due for the survey during construction of the Hull and Machinery of this vessel, and for the survey and assignment of freeboard, as under:-

For survey of Hull.....	£291:	0:	5
" " " Machinery.....	145:	10:	3
" " " and assignment of freeboard.....	8:	8:	0

On payment of these fees, one-quarter of the machinery fee, viz:-£36:7:7 will be due to your office for the survey during installation on board of the engines and boilers, in addition to the hull and freeboard fees, and I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.

I may add that of the balance of the machinery fee £72:15:2 will be due to the Newcastle Office for the survey of the turbine machinery during construction, £36:7:6 to the Glasgow Office for the survey during
