With reference to your first entry report No. 71697 on the Dougle Geared Turbines built by Messrs. A. Parsons Marine Turbine Co. (No. 165) I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough now report that these turbines have been fitted into the S.S. "WAR VIGOUR" (now named "ANDALUSIER"), Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co's No. 10 vessel.

An account for the total fee due for the survey of the machinery has to-day been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping, and the proportion which will be credited to your port for the survey of the turbines will be £72:15:2.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
