Dear Sir,

A. With reference to the Glasgow first entry report No.38663 on the three boilers built by Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd.,(No.403) I have to inform you that a report has now been received from the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough from which it appears that these boilers have been fitted into the "N.1" Standard Vessel "WAR VIGOUR" (now named "ANDALUSIER"), Messrs. The Furness Shipbuilding Co's No.10 vessel.

The proportion of the fee due for the survey of these boilers during construction is £36:7:6 and an account for the fees due has to-day been rendered to the Ministry of Shipping. On payment, your account will be credited with the above mentioned sum, and I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
