We beg to confirm the receipt of your telegram of yesterday, as follows:-

We may add that the "WAR VIGOUR" has now been renamed "ANDALUSIER".

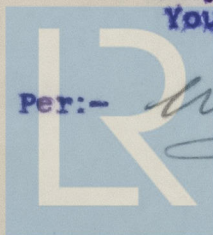
