I have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules for Damage and Docking Survey

Damage : Cause and date unknown

Now Done : On examination found on P.S. in way of No.1 hold shell plate No.2 (from forward) in 1st below sheer set in but found to remain efficient, it is therefore recommended that 'shell plate No.2 (P.S. from forward) in 1st below sheer set in' be made an entry in the S.R.L. Appendix.

Wear and Tear : Welded butts of 4 in No. frames in holds, found fractured were veed and rewelded satisfactorily.

Buckled and torn bracket between hatch end beam and side coaming at aft end of No.1 hatch was renewed satisfactorily.

Steering gear sheaves and pins examined and found satisfactory.

Steering chains examined, annealed, tested and found satisfactory.

Steering gear tested by swinging rudder P.&S. and all found satisfactory.

Minor repairs to rails, doors, hatches etc all satisfactorily completed.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated. I recommend, therefore, that this ship remain as classed with/without fresh record of dry docking 6,65 subject to any outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.
