The reports of survey held while this ship was in drydock at Dublin in January and early this month have now been received from the Society's Surveyors.

The main engine thrust shaft collar was examined and considered to be efficient meantime, but it was recommended that a further examination should be held before the end of January, 1961. The Committee have continued the class subject, *inter alia*, to this matter receiving attention by the time stated.

The screwshaft was drawn for examination, and a record of Drydocking 2.60 and the notation Screwshaft Examined 1.60 have now been assigned.
