ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION IN No.5 TWEEN DECKS. PORT SIDE.

ACCESS HATCH, SHELTER DECK ABREAST No.5 HATCHWAY. PORT SIDE.

COAMING 18" x .40" With hinged steel W.T. Cover secured by toggles.

VENTILATION. 1 Vent 12" dia. coaming 33" x .32 with wood plug and canvas cover.

2 Swan neck ventilators 6" dia with canvas covers.

SIDE SCUTTLES. 7 @ 10" dia of strong construction and fitted with hinged deadlights.

DISCHARGES. 1 - 4" Soil pipe, Baltic type W.C. with storm valve on ships side.

1 - 2" Scupper and wash basin discharge fitted with double automatic self closing valves, easily accessible.
