Dear Sir,

H. I am in receipt of your letter of yesterday's date relative to the motorship "GUIDESMAN", and have to confirm my telegram today as per enclosed copy.

With regard to this case I may say that the vessel's class is subject to a hand pump being fitted on the deck with a suction pipe to the forward cofferdam, and in connection with this matter I may say that on the 4th instant the Rotterdam Surveyors stated they had received a letter from the Owners in which the following appeared:-

"We beg to inform you that we have now blanked off the connection between the forward ballast pump and the forward cofferdam, and a separate hand pump for draining the forward cofferdam has been fitted as per sketch enclosed."

The sketch referred to is now sent for your information and guidance.
