I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for Repairs.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

It was stated that at this time shell plate GA2 (ps from forward) was found locally wasted and holed in way of No.1 hold between frame spaces 162 & 163 (from aft) and that steel doublers had then welded over the wasted section between frame spaces 161/162 and 162/163 inside the hold and a small doubler externally over about the same section.

At this time of examination the 'G' strake of plating was below water level and on examination inside the hold the doublers - stated now fitted - were found satisfactory and tight.

It is recommended that the ships class be made subject to the shell plate GA2 (ps from forward) in way of No.1 hold between frame spaces 161/163 being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next dry docking, considered efficient meantime.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with/without fresh record of dry docking subject to shell plate GA2 (ps from forward) in way of No.1 hold between frame spaces 161/163 being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next dry docking and to all other conditions attached to the ships class being dealt with as previously recommended.

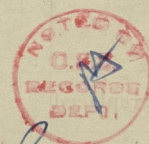
