assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

16 hatches fitted P & S in way of middle line strake to wing ballast tanks. 24" x 18" .40 coaming
12" high with .40 cover plate. Hinged W.T. secured by 6 toggles. Doublers fitted in way. 8 hatches
P & S fitted to existing manholes to wing ballast tanks.

Two tonnage openings of foc'sle bulkhead plated over and replaced by 1 central opening 5'0" x 4'0½",
18" sill with portable steel plates secured by hook bolts 15" apart.
