Nos.1357 & 1359 ships.

We have pleasure in informing you that it has been decided to lay down the above numbered ships in our Wallsend yard.

The vessels are designed for carrying petroleum in bulk and will be propelled by single screw Diesel machinery placed aft. The principal dimensions are 450' B.P. 60'-9" B.M. x 33'-3" D.M., and the load draught to bottom of keel is 25'-9".

The arrangement and scantlings are generally similar to our No.1303 ship recently completed and classed with your Society.....
