on 3rd June, 1953 and subsequently ~~195~~ and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

Hatchcoaming of cross bunker on tween deck renewed and deck plated over.

New 4"/5" air pipes fitted for the oil fuel bunkers and settling tanks, above deck.

Additional air pipes fitted to the oil fuel double bottom tank.

No.4 (former No.4 and drytank) on port and starboard sides, height of air pipes 920 mm above upper deck.

All air pipes to oil fuel tanks fitted with gauze and self closing covers.

Coal hatches on port and starboard side upper deck converted to cargo hatches.
