on 14th May, to 4th June, 1965 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

1. Original forepeak store ventilator coaming removed during course of repairs and deck opening permanently closed.
2. Skylight to lower accommodation aft removed at deck level, deck opening plated over during course of repairs and skylight replaced by a 6" ventilator with coaming of steel, strongly constructed and having wood plug and canvas cover available.
