

PARTICULARS OF DEFECTS, REPAIRS, ALTERATIONS, ETC.

Fire and bilge pump casing to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary before the end of June, 1966.

Now Done.

The casing of the fire and bilge pump now specially examined and no further wastage found. It is therefore recommended that the fire and bilge pump casing be specially examined and dealt with as necessary before the end of June, 1967. (12 months' limit) Continued efficient meanwhile.

The reason for repairs must be stated and those on account of damage, the alleged cause of which must be given, should be detailed separately from wear and tear repairs. State what action has been taken regarding items which are subjects of class. State also where appropriate, for the information of the Technical Records Dept., the material of the defective item and whether it is a forging, casting or welded fabrication. Any alterations in existing particulars in the Register Book should also be reported above.
