This vessel was built in 1939 to Germanischer Lloyd requirements and Classification with this Society is now desired.

First Entry reports on the main machinery and electrical equipment together with some plans have been examined and the details are such as could be accepted when a satisfactory reply has been received to enquiry re. pumping arrangements.

The machinery has been examined on a Continuous Survey basis ( commenced 1.46) and the cycle is now complete except for the examination of the intermediate shafting.

One of the original auxiliary generator sets has now been replaced by a new set built under survey, and for which the torsional vibration characteristics were approved in Secretary's letter of 7. 7. 48. to Messrs. Atlas Diesel Co.

*The torsional vibration characteristics of the main machinery have not been investigated & the Mach 1 Certificate should be endorsed accordingly. The Agent should be advised & the services offered to make the necessary investigation, if desired.*

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel WILL BE eligible for the Record LMC CS 4.48, 4.48 when the pumping arrangements have been satisfactorily dealt with.

The Liverpool Surveyors should be informed in terms of endorsement dated 7. 9. 48. re. pumping arrangements and their comments requested at an early date.

Note for S.R.L.:- An early opportunity should be taken to examine the intermediate shafting.
