6. Equivalent Arrangements.- Deviations from the Rules will be allowed provided they are submitted to the Committee and considered by them to be equivalent to the requirements of the Rules. The Builders shall obtain the Owner's consent to such deviations when the Committee deem it necessary.
7. Loading of Ships. - The scantlings and arrangements given in the Rules do not provide for any special concentration of loading and if such is adopted the Committee may require additional strengthening to be fitted.

Where it is desired to make provision for exceptions to ballast or loaded conditions, the necessary particulars are to be given on the plans when these are submitted for approval.
