Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in August 1943.

NOW DONE:- Additional lavatory installed in Engineers' deckhouse above the level
of the freeboard deck, having sanitary discharge fitted with ^a3" diam. automatic
non-return valve at ship's side in tween deck space, port side, in an accessible
position forward of fresh water tank. ✓

Steering gear hatch removed and aperture in upper deck permanently closed
with welded plate. Poop deck house extended aft approx. 7'-6" to provide ✓
lavatories and toilet facilities for native crew. Sanitary discharge fitted
with 4" dia. double automatic non-return valve at ship's side in steering gear
space, starboard side. ✓

Original lavatories in crew's accommodation aft, below the level of upper
deck, permanently removed together with two S.D. automatic non-return valves in
way of No. 5 hold, starboard side, and openings efficiently closed. ✓

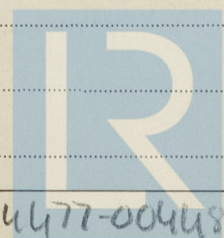
