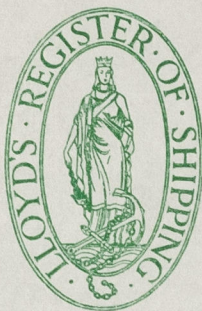

recommending that she be retained as now classed without fresh record  
of survey, subject to shell plating port side in way of deep tank top  
flat in No. 1 hold being further examined and dealt with as found  
necessary and that conditions present attached to vessel's class  
being dealt with as previously recommended.*
