S.S. "BLUE MARLIN"

With reference to the Special Survey, due at the end of May, 1964 postponement of which until the end of next month approved, the Owners state that this inspection, together with the Boiler and Steampipe Surveys, will be carried out when the vessel is drydocked at Keeling in the first week of June, and I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention.

The conditions of class requiring the examination of the port inboard bilge pump and port outboard general service pump water end cylinders and main condenser water box division plate will also be dealt with on the above occasion.

No part of the Special Survey of the hull has yet been held, and to complete the Engine Survey for the record ES 9.64 the pumping arrangements require to be examined and the evaporator safety valves adjusted.

You should advise this Office immediately should the Special Survey not be carried out as now stated.
