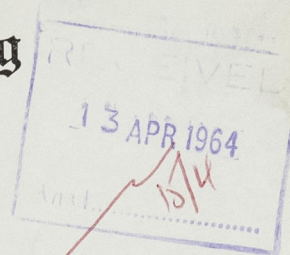

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 3rd inst. with enclosures in connection with the survey of a water tube boiler for the above named vessel.

I have contacted Mr. Sorenson of Paxsno Inc., who is the Owner's Representative, and I am advised that the boiler is at the Willamette Shipyard in Richmond, California.
