

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo regarding Glasgow First Entry Report No. 66280 on the Motor Vessel "EMPIRE HIGHWAY" and have to state that the deep tank was tested to Rule requirements, but that no echo-sounding device has been fitted.

As regards the heating surface of the oil and exhaust gas boiler, the Surveyor confirms that this should have been given as 2482 square feet.

In the circumstances, an amended account for £16. 10. 0., plus £4. 2. 6., the charge for the supervision of the specification, making a total of £20. 12. 6., has been rendered to Messrs. Barclay, Curle & Co., Ltd., and I shall be much obliged if you will kindly have the report amended accordingly.




