I shall, however, be obliged if you will request the Surveyors to furnish the required particulars regarding the gas condenser circulating pumps which have been omitted from the report and also what alternative means, if any, are furnished for dealing with the exhaust steam from the compressor engines.

As it is not the Society's practice to mention proprietary articles in its publications, I shall be glad to learn whether "Slag Wool" is a correct description of "Stillite". At the same time I shall be glad to learn whether the spare gear has been checked.
