Dear Sir,

I beg to transmit herewith for the consideration of the Committee Glasgow Report No. 66266 on the Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances of the new Motor Vessel "EMPIRE HIGHWAY", together with London R.M.C. Report No. 1293, for issue of the necessary certificate.

At the same time I would refer you to London letter of the 29th July last, and would state that the total refrigerated cargo capacity is now given as 368,000 in 10 chambers as against the estimated figure of 409,000, on which the fee quoted was based.

In the circumstances, on completion of the vessel it is proposed to render an account to the Builders for £30, the rule fee for the actual capacity of the chambers, and on payment, one-third thereof, viz: £10, will be credited to your Office instead of £12 as given in the London letter.
