



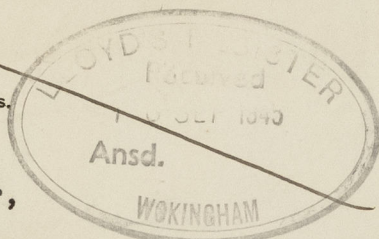

It is not quite clear what particulars are required to be obtained by us in connection with Notice 1803.

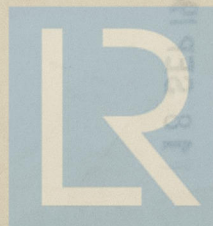
There is no apparatus available at Lisbon to take torsion-graph readings should this be required.
