Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in NOVEMBER 1943.

## ALTERATIONS DURING CONVERSION FOR CARRIAGE OF ORE.

continuous longitudinal trunk fitted a main deck from fore bulkhead to within half bulkhead, bulkheads E.W. where pierced by trunk.

6 cargo holds formed:-

No 1 Hold 13,055mm x 7,275mm

No 2 Hold 13,445mm x 7,275mm.

No 3 Hold 14,275mm x 7,275mm.

No 4 Hold 12,480mm x 7,275mm

No 5 Hold 13,430mm x 7,275mm.


No 6 Hold 12,200mm x 7,275mm.

Welded steel watertight hatch covers fitted to Nos 1-6 hatches, each hatch No 12456

cover in 5 sections each .29" thick with 4 webs 10" x .29" with 7.8" x .47" face bars

Access doors to holds through trunk side 1' 0" x 2' 3" W.T. with 6 sills and 24" sills doors operable from both sides. 1 door to each hold Nos 1, 2, 3 on port side Nos 4, 5, 6 on Starboard side, openings compensated.

12 in the Access manholes to wing ballast tanks 21" x 29" adequately compensated and fitted with .72" thick watertight steel covers secured by 26 in the studs  $\frac{3}{4}$ " diam spaced 3.75" apart.



AIR PIPES 24 in the 6" diam and 12 in the 8" diam, 36" in height with wooden plugs now fitted on freeboard deck.

PUMP ROOM Deck house removed & bridge deck house moved aft covering existing pump room openings in freeboard deck. Access to pumps through w.t. steel door with 24" sill through trunk side, with bridge space. (operable both sides).

GANGWAY Guard rails on trunk deck PoS of hatch coaming, 2 rails with stanchions 3' 6" high & 5' apart, stanchions  $\frac{1}{2}'' \times \frac{1}{2}''$  flats, welded.

FOSCÉ BULKHEAD now closed by portable steel plates (PoS) secured by bolts spaced 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pitch, this replaces storm boards previously fitted.
