Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in AUGUST, 1943

Removal of Temporary Accommodation for Gunners in No.5 'tween deck (p & s)

- (1) Side scuttles in ship's sides (p & s) removed and openings closed by steel spigot patches E.W. and riveted in place. /
- (2) Ventilator coamings on upper deck abreast No.5 hatch (2p & 1s) removed and openings closed by steel spigot patches E.W. and riveted in place. /
- (3) One 24" dia escape scuttle on upper deck abaft No.5 hatch removed and opening closed by a steel plate E.W. in place. /
- (4) W.C's and washbasins removed and pipes and valves removed and openings in shell closed by steel spigot patches E.W. in place. /
