A question has arisen in regard to the equipment of anchors and chain cables of the Steamer "LEELAVATHI", which vessel was originally constructed as a Basset type trawler in India.

Enquiry has been made by this Society's Southampton Surveyors of the Naval Store Officer at Portsmouth Dockyard, who states that all the original records of equipment supplied to these vessels are in your possession.

It is understood that the appropriate reference number applicable to this ship is "NCP Number 6", and it will be of great assistance to this Society if you would be so good as to furnish me with any information you may have in your possession as to the weights of the anchors, the length and diameter of the chain cable, and the tests applied, in respect of this equipment supplied to this vessel.
