Dear Mr. Sladden,

With reference to the equipment of Bassett type trawlers built in India, I have seen the Naval Store Officer at Portsmouth Dockyard who tells me that all the original records of equipment supplied to these vessels have been sent to the Admiralty.

To the best of his recollection the equipment, which was supplied from Portsmouth, was of 'Merchant Quality' which means that it is covered by LPH Certificates.

Application for details of these should be made to the Director of Stores (Whitehall) but it will be necessary to quote what is called the 'NCP Number' - i.e. the Job Number of each vessel concerned as they will have no knowledge of the vessel's name, Yard Number etc.
