Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 3rd March regarding the above named vessel and the remarks concerning the testing of the chain cables are noted.

Meanwhile, a letter from Mr. F. G. Cooper, Madras, has been received stating he has not received your letter of the 9th February regarding condition of assignment and that he has asked you for a copy to be sent to him.

Mr. Cooper has no further information about the chain cables except that another length of used cable without certificate - was placed on board, date not mentioned.

If there is a testing house at Calcutta it would appear that the best solution to the problem of acceptance of the cables of this vessel is to have them tested at Calcutta and to have the anchors weighed. I am writing to Calcutta to inquire about facilities and will await the result of your enquiry from Portsmouth before advising Owners.
