Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo respecting the anchors and cables of the ex Basset type trawler "LEELAVATHI", and note your remarks.

I am communicating with the Principal Surveyor at Southampton in an endeavour to get some more information from the Stores Department at Portsmouth, and will let you have their comments when they come to hand.

Meantime I think it well to let you know that when we classed the "FATIMA" ex Basset trawler "SHILLONG" at Karachi in 1948, it was possible to assign the figure "1" as the equipment of anchors and cables was tested at the Karachi Port Trust Testing House in the presence of Mr. Johnston.
