I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant respecting the Steamer "INDIRA" ex "CALOUTTA", the contents of which are noted.

With regard to the remarks in your concluding paragraph, it is not the Society's practice to withhold the issue of certificates pending payment of the survey fees. In any case, the question of withholding Loadline Certificates only arises if the fee for the appropriate Loadline Survey is not paid.

In these circumstances the issue appears to devolve on the fact that payment has not been received for Classification Surveys previously carried out. If efforts to obtain the payment of such fees fail to secure the desired result, the Committee would be entitled to withhold the assignment of class, which would have the effect of causing the revision of the Freeboard Survey fees as these would then have to be computed as for an unclassified ship.

It is concluded from your remarks that you may have reason to suppose that difficulty may be experienced in collecting the fees after the satisfactory completion of the Classification Survey. If this proves to be the case you should immediately notify this office asking for further instructions.
