Dear Sirs,

H.M.I.S. "CALCUTTA".

We are in receipt of your letter of the 4th instant outlining your proposals in the case of the above vessel.

In reply we have to advise you that for the Classification Survey, it will be necessary to submit the whole of the main and auxiliary machinery including the boiler, for survey by an Engineer Surveyor to this Society.

There is no reason why the survey should not commence as soon as the vessel arrives in Calcutta and the Drydocking Survey can be completed before the final submission of your plans.

We would point out however, that it is very important that the plans detailed in our previous letters together with plans of proposed alterations be submitted at an early date in order to avoid delay in completing the Classification Survey.

In the event of your not being familiar with the Ship Repair capabilities of this port we strongly advise you to engage a reputable firm to carry out your requirements.
