The engine and boiler were made under Special Survey, but not the vessel. Classification is now desired.

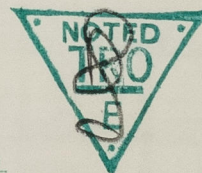
Revised arrangements of pumping and electrical installation have been approved and examined.
