MANDO. — Piraeus, Aug. 31. — Motor vessel Mando sank at 4 40 p.m., Aug. 30, in deep water in lat. 39 11 N., long. 24 50 E., loaded with 1,400 tons of cement in bags from Varna to Benghazi. Crew picked up by Russian motor vessel Vaga and landed Lemnos, where owner presently interviewing crew. — Salvage Association's Surveyor.

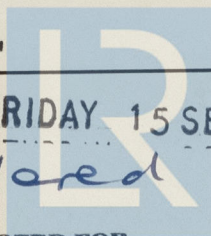
