We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter with accompanying report of defects in the main engines of above vessel. These engines were made by Messrs. Buckley & Taylor of Oldham and installed by Chas. D. Holmes & Co. of Hull. This being the case, the local surveyors accepted the main engines as a whole unit, attended two basin trials and had minor defects then revealed made right to the satisfaction of the Naval representatives. Everyone concerned, including the Chief Engineer, was satisfied that the vessel, previous to leaving Hull, was in an efficient seaworthy condition.

We have attached our remarks on the report.


