- "BLACKBIRD", Rpt. 52058: £71 (H); £36 (M); £17.10. (E.L.)
- "ANNET" Rpt. 52066: £71 (H); £36 (M); £17.10. (E.L.)
- "GRILSE" Rpt. 52090: £55 (H); £31 (M); £17.10. (E.L.)
- "DABCHICK" Rpt. 52088: £71 (H); £36 (M); £17.10. (E.L.)
- "POLLOCK" : £55 (H); £31 (M); £17.10. (E.L.)

It will be noted that two of these vessels, viz: "BLACKBIRD" and "DABCHICK" are Controlled Minelayers, the Builders stating that they have been advised that the new arrangement applied to this type of vessel as well as "Fish" class, "Military" class and Admiralty type A/S M/S Trawlers.
