We, the Undersigned Surveyors, beg to state that the Special Survey No.3 is now being carried out upon this vessel. The Survey is proceeding satisfactorily, but it is not anticipated that it will be completed until shortly before the vessel sails from this Port. Upon satisfactory completion the vessel will be recommended to the Committee of the Society for continuance of classification in the Register Book with Notation of S.S. No.3, with date of completion.

The requirements of the International Convention Load Line Renewal Survey are also being complied with, and this document should be presented to the Representative of the Dutch Government, with a view to the vessel's Load Line Certificate being renewed, valid until the end of August 1946, in readiness for issue upon the satisfactory completion of the survey now in hand.
