Hall Ltd., attend at their Works at Dartford, Kent, on the 12.7.55., and subsequently for the purpose of surveying the overhaul of Three carbon dioxide two pass refrigerator condenser coils stated to have been removed from the s.s. "DONGDYK".

The coils were cleaned and examined, various repairs carried out.

On completion of repairs the coils were hydraulically tested to 3000 lbs. per sq. in. and later by air at 1500 lbs. per sq. in. whilst submerged in water.

For identification the coils and casings have been stamped with the initials of the undersigned.
