With reference to Your classing letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the First Entry reports Nos. 8141 a, b & c, and with regard thereto I beg to inform You that the numbers of the W.T. Stanchions are as follows. Ten W. T. B. to Shelter deck, One W. T. B. Upperdeck, One W. T. B. to Orlopdeck, One ditto to tunnel deck, as clearly described in my letter of the 6th July 1920.

With regard to the maincable carrying 1000 Amperes which was stated on the First Entry report to consist of 4 x 16 Wires each 13 S.W.G. diameter, You will surely observe that this is a scribal error and should read 4 cables each 61 wires of 13 S.W.G.

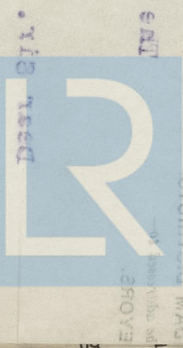
