

M.V. "DORABELLA"

IT IS SUBMITTED the Surveyors at Southampton
be informed that the fee "For Classification Survey"
is the scale fee for the classification of a normal
ship of identical tonnage and power
14th November, 1949.

Dear Sirs, additional fee for "Survey of Conversion
from L.C.S. to Cargo Vessel", is on account of the extra
visits. I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant
with its enclosure respecting the "DORABELLA", the
contents of which are noted.

S. In reply I have to say that the fee for the
Classification Survey is the appropriate fee for a
normal ship of the tonnage and power of the "Dorabella".
This does not take into account additional visits
which may be required in connection with major
alterations or repairs. The additional fee, therefore,
for the conversion to a cargo ship is on account of
the extra visits demanded in this respect.

50% of the fee for this first classification survey
is due to Mr. McQueen on payment, as distinct from
the 80% agreed in cases of periodical surveys for
class maintenance. (Due regard has been paid to the
visits made by the London Surveyors.)
