We would be pleased to hear from you whether in fact you consider the vessels were in Class at the time we sailed them from Maracaibo to Curacao. We were not undertaking a voyage with cargo but merely one voyage, to enable the vessels to reach Curacao and such voyage was undertaken as a necessity and a condition of the Sale Agreement."

We may add that the vessels are still lying up at Curacao.
