Referring to your letter of the 11th December last regarding the above named vessel, I may say that the Jacksonville Surveyor reports as follows:

1. Yes, the full requirements of a Special Survey (D) have been complied with and the suffix letters (Dr.) should be included in the Special Survey Notation.
2. The Strums were removed for examination of the plating in way also that the Cofferdam and pump room were examined.
3. Mean Diameter of the Chain Cable was reported in error, and should have read 2 1/16" Dia..
4. The number of Wing Tanks was reported in error, should have been ten (10) instead of six (6).
5. Circular 2032 has been complied with.
6. The items not described as "good" on the Rpt.9 or otherwise reported do not apply to this ship.

Regarding the deck drillings, <sup>the Surveyor states</sup> the thicknesses given on the plating sheet were those at two locations on the deck as required by the Rules, representing thicknesses amidships and at the ends. The drillings of the trunk were at amidships.

Viewed in this matter, little deterioration is evident and is not considered necessary to renew any plating. The Surveyor confirmed that the deck plating is in good condition.
