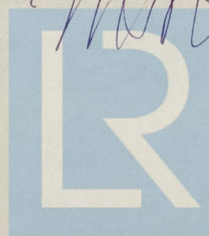
In reply to your letter of the 16th instant regarding the electrical equipment of the Sun Hull Nos. 233 and 240, I have to confirm that with the exception of,—

- a. armored and lead covered wing and flameproof lighting fittings in cargo pump room, and
- b. number of lighting fittings in aft accommodation exceeding in number the 10 permitted by the Rules when supplied from a single final sub-circuit

the remaining requirements of the Rules for Electrical Equipment are complied with and the installation is to the Surveyor's satisfaction.

Copies of the Westinghouse letter referred to on the back page of the Electric Light Report regarding test reports of essential motors are enclosed herewith for the above vessel, and also in the case of the "SEAKAY", Phl. Report No. 8286.
