
The class is subject to top gudgeon of stern frame (E.W. 11,33) being specially examined on ship's return to Denmark within a year from 11,33.

The Copenhagen Surveyors now report the ship placed in dry dock, bottom coated and minor repairs effected.

The E.W. repair to top gudgeon of stern frame, as above, specially examined and found good and the Surveyors recommend same be examined at the next dry docking.

It is submitted the ship appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 12,34 subject as recommended.
