Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of yesterday's date regarding the tanker "VRISSI" and would confirm that I have been in touch with the Rotterdam Office this afternoon who assure me that a Surveyor will be ready to visit the ship tomorrow morning to carry out the examination of the steam cylinder of the circulating engine which you state has been renewed.

As regards the second paragraph of your letter it is understood that the request for twenty-four hours notice referred to a visit to Thameshaven. This is of course a very awkward spot at which to arrange an immediate visit, and as such might be regarded as exceptional.

It is suggested that in any future similar case Mr. Antonopoulos should make direct request to me so that the necessary instructions could be given or at least a proper explanation afforded.
