The material has been tested by the Surveyors to The British Corporation Register; the boiler scantlings are in accordance with the approved plan for a working pressure of 225 lbs. per square inch, and the workmanship was satisfactory.

The boilers were satisfactorily hydraulic tested in accordance with the rule requirements and were stamped for identification with the test pressure, date and surveyor's initials.
