I have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules for General Examination for postponement Special Survey until the end of October, 1967 (Vessel Tanker 46 yrs. old).

The Vessel generally examined afloat in accordance with the instructions to Surveyors Part 3a 1963 and amendment No. 16 and the condition found to be such that the Special Survey could be postponed until the end of October, 1967 as desired by the Owners. No reason was found to recommend drydocking at this time.

I declare that the items detailed in this report (except as stated otherwise) comply with the requirements of the Merchant Shipping (Cargo Ship Construction and Survey) Rules 1965, applicable to this ship, and are in all respects satisfactory for the service on which the ship is intended to ply namely International voyages/voyages within the limits

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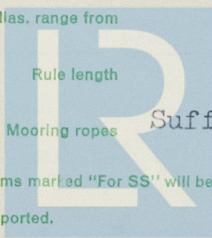
