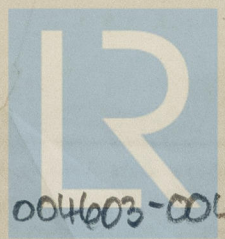
These Tanks have been examined by the undersigned, and the three large ones tested to 7½ lbs hydraulic pressure and found tight and satisfactory at that pressure.
