# LLOYD'S REGISTER OF SHIPPING

This is to Certify that at the request of Messrs. Gilman & Co., Ltd., Lloyd's Agents, Hong Kong, the undersigned Surveyor did attend on board the S.S. "SYROS", 7146 tons gross, of Syros, on the 21st February, 1968, for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of alleged damage to the boiler.

Enquiries were made of the Owners' representatives, the Chief Engineer and the Master, who stated that they had no knowledge of damage to the boiler.

The vessel was undergoing Classification Boiler Survey and the only repairs noted consisted of renewal of the port boiler air heater-tubes in their entirety (265 total), which upon examination by the undersigned, were considered to being repaired due to wear & tear, and not damage.
