ss. "SYROS".

I acknowledge receipt of your letters dated the 12th and 13th February, and have to inform you that in view of the very exceptional circumstances referred to, the case has been reconsidered.

So far as the Screwshaft Survey is concerned the Committee have instructed me to inform you that, taking into account past history, they are agreeable, in this particular instance, to the Survey being postponed until the ship completes her current charter on the 30th June 1968. This is on the strict understanding that the vessel will proceed for drydocking and Screwshaft Survey without fail immediately on completion of the charter. You are requested to inform me of the drydocking venue at the earliest possible date so that instructions can be sent to the Port concerned.

It is noted that the Main Boiler Survey will be completed at an early date.

The Machinery condition of class relating to the windlass steam cylinder block which expired at the end of January, should be renewed, or examined by a Surveyor to the Society with a view to extending the limit at a very early date, and I shall be glad to learn what definite arrangements are proposed to be made for this matter to be dealt with.

A separate communication will be forwarded to you regarding the Safety Equipment Certificate.
